This work extends the locustream project originated in 2006 by French based Audio in art research group "Locus Sonus", which offers an online platform for streamed open-microphones from all round the world.

Several microphones are set up in various locations, which open the possibility to continuously listen to different soundscapes. Cedric Maridet's work adds several open-microphones in Hong Kong to the existing ones, and creates a generative system to recombine the different sound events from this global sound map into the listener's head.
